(2) TWO WEEKS PRIOR

- _____ Remind participants to **dress appropriately for the weather that day** as activities will be outside. Participants are suggested to bring water bottles, sunscreen and/or mosquito repellent.

GUEST POLICIES AND EXPECTATIONS

Being outdoors is what we're all about! The guidelines below are in place for the safety of everyone at Camp Discovery and we ask that everyone follow them during the visit.

1. **Camp Discovery is a big place (116 acres).** Please stay with your group at all times, we don't want anyone getting lost, and you might miss something interesting if you are off by yourself!
2. **Be prepared for seasonal and mild inclement weather**, bringing jackets, rain jackets or sweatshirts as needed. Closed toe shoes are a MUST! No flip flops PLEASE.
3. You may play some running games while you are at Camp Discovery, but when you are on sidewalks, steep hills, or on the trails, **please walk - it's safer and you'll see more!**
4. You will need to have your hands free for doing activities on the trail, so **leave cell phones, iPads and all unnecessary items in your bus or classroom.**
5. We want you to have a good time and a safe time while you are here. Please **enjoy plants, animals, rocks and sticks using a hands-off approach**, unless instructed otherwise. We'll have plenty of hands-on time; just need to be sure it's safe for everyone! Poison ivy and fire ants are a part of the natural world.
6. Try to walk carefully so as not to disturb the rocks, logs, and leaves that provide homes for little things. Every living creature has a purpose for its existence. We ask that you **please respect our plants and all "creepy crawlies."**
7. Camp Discovery is a beautiful place to learn and live in harmony with nature and other people. Let's be **kind to each other and the plant and animal life surrounding us.** We should appreciate natural beauty, learn from it, and respect its purpose in nature.
