## Discovery Days for Pre-K/K Students

### Habitat Hunt

Using all of our senses, we explore habitats large and small within a forest ecosystem at Camp Discovery. From seeds to fallen logs, students will learn about trees, their life cycle and how they provide a home for different plants and animals. Students will even meet some of the different animals that live there.

### Organisms in their Environment

Students will learn what organisms are and discover their basic needs for survival. During a nature walk, we use our senses to search for plants, animals and fungi in the habitats of Camp Discovery. Through a live animal encounter, students learn how these different organisms use their bodies to move, find food and protect themselves.

### The Giving Tree

Students will listen to the heartwarming story "The Giving Tree" by Shel Silverstein. After reading the story, children will embark on a tree hike to learn about the parts of a tree, collect leaves, and make a leaf crown of their very own.
